(TECHNICAL) INFORMATION ABOUT THE PERFORMANCE

LIGHT

We will use all lighting from the venue, as well as your lighting console.
Please see attachment for the lighting plot.

SOUND

FOH: Acoustic music we'll bring ourselves. Besides we like to use the Genelec 1030A speaker or an equivalent speaker.

PERFORMING AREA:

8 x 8 meters. Smaller performing area can be discussed, minimum space required: 6 x 6 meters. The audience will be placed in the regular theatre setting. We'd like to use some pillows on the floor, so the children can sit at the front of the

stage. Please inform us when there are no pillows available in the venue.

FLOOR:

White ballet floor, provided by the venue.

The floor needs to be suitable for dance, so no direct concrete or stone.

PROPS:

Asked by the venue (when performing outside The Netherlands):

- Microphone standard
- Beanbag / Fatboy, size: approximately 1,30m x 1,60m (condition doesn't matter, we'll bring a white cover.)
- Wooden box, size: 0,80 x 0,52 x 0,57m

We'll bring ourselves:

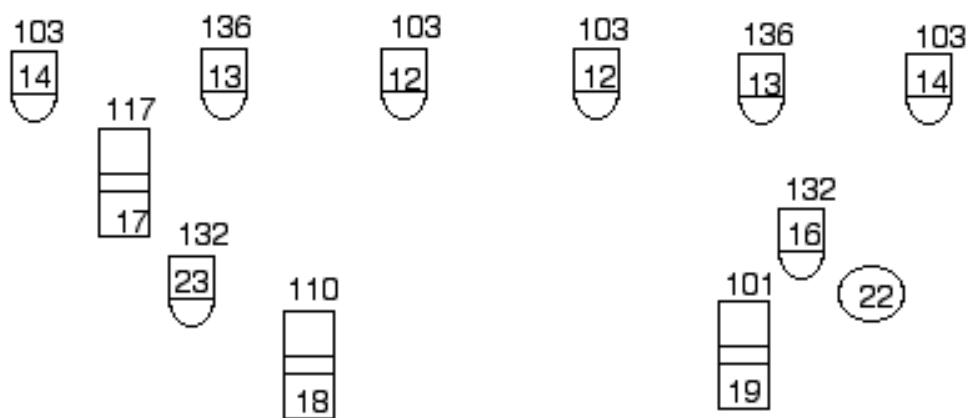
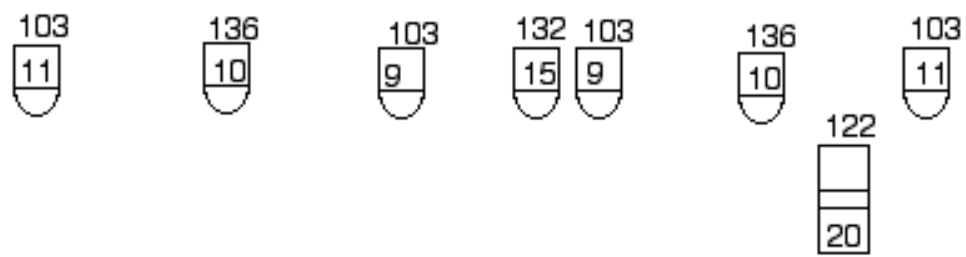
- Mixer
